The internship will offer students and young adults a structured experience working one-on-one with Governor Kitzhaber and campaign staff. Interns learn basic skills that allow them to analyze issues and articulate solutions to the pressing problems of the day. Interns learn that activism and participation in the democratic process yield results.

Though responsibilities vary, most internship's will include:

- Working with the campaign and community organizations to increase visibility and name identification throughout Oregon by coordinating community events and candidate appearances.
- Working with our web and social networking teams to enhance our online presence.
- Working with coalition partners to coordinate grassroots campaign activities. Including phonebanks, canvasses, and community event appearances.

Interns have the opportunity to work on a campaign where they learn about public interest issues, gain political knowledge, and see how the democratic process works.

The campaign is currently recruiting field and finance interns to work out of our Portland Headquarters, but we also have satellite internship opportunities available throughout Oregon.
